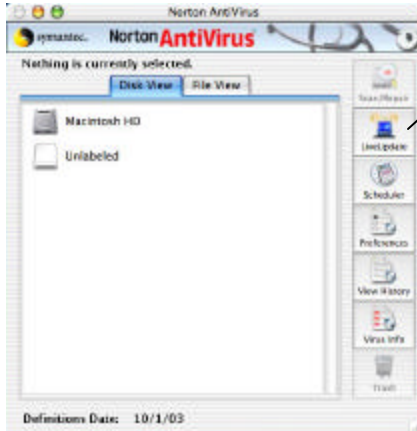


## How to Configure Automatic Updates with Norton Antivirus for Macintosh OS X

### Important Information

Setting automatic updates is an important step that needs to be done after installing Norton Antivirus. By setting automatic updates, you ensure that you are fully protected against the latest virus threats. New viruses are discovered daily. Protect yourself and your computer investment by updating Norton Antivirus.



Double click on the **Hard Drive** icon on your computer desktop.

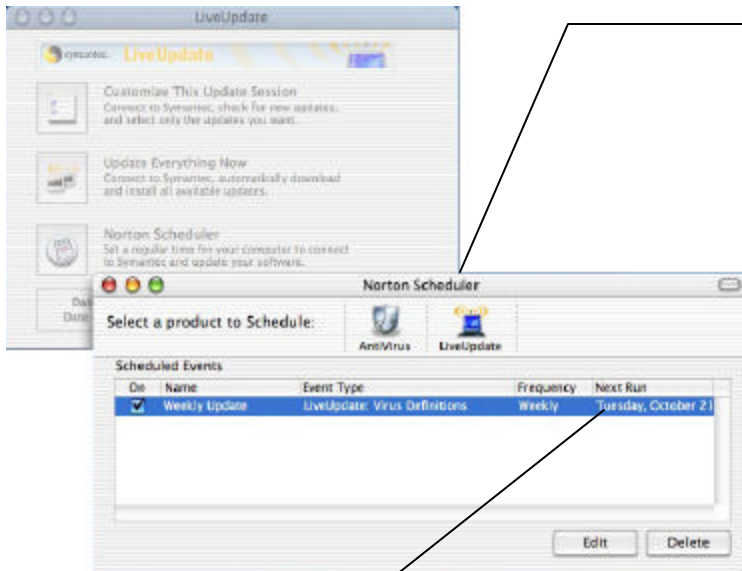
Double click on the **Applications** folder.

Double click on **Norton AntiVirus**.

This screen should appear.

Click on **Live Update**.

Follow the instructions below



Click on the **Norton Scheduler** button. The following window should appear.

By Default, Norton is set for Monthly Updates.

Select the Monthly Update schedule and click **Edit**.

Rename it to **Weekly Update** and set the frequency to **Weekly**.

Select **Virus Definitions** for the **Product to Update**.

Select a **Time**. The default is now.

Click the **X** when done, then click **Save**.

You can select any **Time** that you wish. Just be sure that the computer is turned on and has internet access during the time you

You can create additional scheduled events in the same manner to update different parts of the Antivirus program. The most important is the Virus Definitions. Norton Antivirus uses these definitions to identify virus threats to your computer.

Be sure that **Auto Protect** remains **ON** so that your computer is always protected.
