

Special Information for EarthLink Internet Service

This document has been prepared to assist you in creating and managing a connection to the EarthLink internet service. This is a dialup service using your modem and phone line. Use this document in conjunction with the **Dialup Configuration** instructions for the computer you are using. Please refer to <http://helpdesk.bradley.edu/dialup.shtml>.

Important

All modern computers have everything needed to create a connection to Earthlink. Do not install any additional software for your Earthlink connection. Earthlink software could disable your current Bradley connections.

Before you set up a connection to Earthlink, there is some information that you will need. This includes:

- ✓ **Local Access Phone Number:** Your local access number from the Earthlink website.
Detailed instructions below.
- ✓ **Your User name:** Your Earthlink login name.
- ✓ **Your Password:** Your Earthlink password.

Once you have your **local access number**, your **Earthlink user name**, and your **Earthlink password**, you are ready to create a connection to Earthlink.

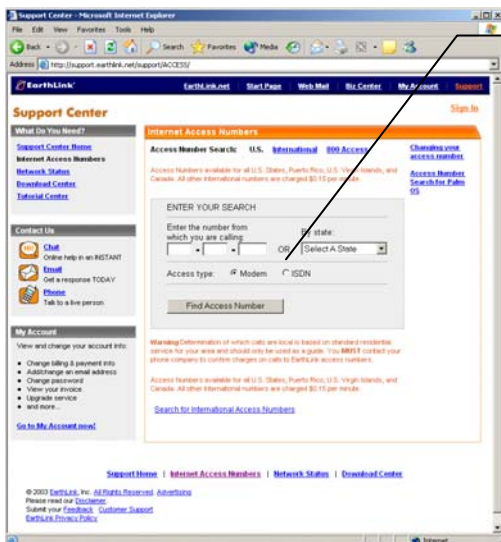
About your Earthlink user name:

Add **@earthlink.net** after the user name when you set up your connection. This will ensure that your username and password are recognized correctly.

Remember: local or long distance phone charges may still apply within your area code

You can find a local access number in two ways:

1. Enter the number **from** where you will be calling. This could be your home phone number, the hotel number, or the place where your conference is being held.
 2. Search for a local number by state. You may be presented with a much larger list to choose from.
